Leverage many of the 2015 changes and OC experience  
Thanks to Sean Peisert, EE, and the 2015 OC

Support PC Chairs efforts for increasing program size & quality  
Explore options for shaping program, reviewing process  
Continue "Best Reviewer" awards

Quality of student experience (e.g., Sunday student gathering)  
Revisit Room Block in anticipation of growth

Anticipate financial demands to support services (e.g., A/V recording)  
Increase donations to backstop SPW fold-in, plus rising costs  
Look at increasing registration fees a modest amount

# General Chair's Goals [Achieved]

Maintain program size (55 papers) w/o dual track

411 papers, 13.4% acceptance rate

Program Chairs improve multi-round review process, include Shadow PC

1425 reviews, 826 comments

“Best Reviewer” awards given & sponsored by the TC

Quality of student experience: Speed Mentoring Event Wednesday

Fully eliminated paper proceedings

Increased room block, 99% used

Slight increase (6.5K) in donations (from record-high 2015 levels)

Increased registration fees by a modest \$30

578 total registrations (comparable to 2013 & 2014 @ 580 and 570)

SPW registration: 221
